## Formation of seven new districts in the State of Manipur - Assignment of Lead Bank Responsibility

Please refer to the <u>circular FIDD.CO.LBS.BC.No.23/02.08.001/2016-17 dated</u>

<u>March 9, 2017</u> on assigning lead bank responsibility to the seven newly created districts in the State of Manipur.
