Section II: Instructions to Bidders

2.1 **College of Agricultural Banking, Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Campus, Pune** invites sealed Bids from the tenders to submit a technical and financial bid as per the Special condition (**Section III**) and Bank's requirement (**Section V**) in this document.

2.2 RFP Document:

2.2.1 RFP shall consist of documents having seven Sections along with any schedules, addendum or corrigendum etc., issued by Reserve Bank of India for the purpose.

2.2.2 Bidders are advised to study all the sections of RFP documents thoroughly. Submission of bid shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the tender documents with full understanding of its implications.

2.3 Obtaining of RFP documents:

(a) The RFP documents enclosed.

2.4 Pre-bid Meeting

Reserve Bank of India shall conduct pre-bid meeting(s) at the time and venue mentioned in clause 1.2(e) of Notice Inviting Bid, to answer any queries / provide clarifications that the Bidders may have in connection with the Project and to give them relevant information regarding the same.

2.5 Amendment to RFP Document

2.5.1 At any time prior to the deadline for the submission of Bids, Reserve Bank of India may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification or query raised by a prospective Bidder, modify the RFP by an amendment.

2.5.2 The said amendment in the form of the addendum/ corrigendum will be uploaded in MSTC portal and RBI web site for information to all prospective Bidders on or before the last date mentioned in Clause 1.2(g) of Notice Inviting Bid. This communication will be binding on the bidders. Prospective bidders should promptly acknowledge receipt of the addendum/corrigendum and upload duly signed on MSTC portal with Part I. The addendum(s) issued will form part of the RFP documents.

2.5.3 In order to provide prospective Bidders reasonable time for preparing their Bids after taking into account such amendments, the Reserve Bank of India may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Bids. Details of extension if any will be uploaded on MSTC portal.

2.6 Preparation of bid

2.6.1 Technical bid (Section I to VI)

- (i) Sections I to IX are the part of technical bid. All the sections must be signed by the bidders.
- (ii) Bidder must fill all the details as specified in the Section and upload the leaflet /brochure of product on MSTC portal.

- (iii) EMD shall be part of technical bid & the amount of EMD is indicated in clause 1.2 (b)
- (iv) The RFP documents must be filled in English and all entries must be made by hand and written in ink and uploaded on MSTC portal. If any of the documents is missing or unsigned, the tender may be considered invalid by the Bank at its discretion.

2.6.2 Financial Bid: (Refer section VII)

- (i) **Currency of Bid:** Bid prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only. These prices should have quoted in MSTC portal format and shall include all costs associated with the work including any out of pocket / mobilization expenses, all taxes, charges, levies, cess, insurance, transportation, entry taxes, Labour, other Govt. Taxes like GST etc.
- (ii) Any correction in the amount should be authenticated by the bidder.
- (iii) The price should be quoted strictly in line with the price schedule leaving no column blank whatsoever to avoid any ambiguity.
- (iv) The bidder should ensure that all columns of the price schedule may be duly filled and no column is left blank. After opening of the price bid, no clarifications and conditions whatsoever shall be entertained by the RBI.
- (v) If any columns of the price schedule are found blank than the tender of the respective bidders shall be treated as non-responsive, and will be summarily rejected by the RBI and further EMD shall be forfeited. However, Bank may also take the review in this matter as per clause 3.1.2(e) if required.

2.6.3 It will be imperative on each bidder to fully acquaint himself with all the local conditions and factors, which would have any effect on the performance of the contract and cost of the items. No request for the change of price or time schedule of delivery of items shall be entertained, on account of any local condition or factor once the offer is accepted by the Bidders.

2.7 Period of Validity of Bids

Bids shall remain valid for acceptance by RBI for the period indicated in **clause** 1.2 (n). This period will be further mutually extended, if required.

2.8 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) / Bid security:

- 2.8.1 The Bidders shall enclose Bid Security (in form of DD)/NEFT/Bank Guarantee with their Bid for an amount indicated in Clause 1.2 (b) of Notice Inviting Bid. Format of Bank Guarantee in lieu of EMD is at Section VIII. The Bank Guarantee should be valid for six months from the date issue of tender.
- 2.8.2 The Bid Security shall be in form of NEFT and proof of the same shall be uploaded on MSTC portal. No interest on Bid Security shall be paid.
- 2.8.3 **Bids not accompanied by Bid Security, shall be treated as non-responsive, and will be summarily rejected by the RBI.**
- 2.8.4 The Bid securities of unsuccessful Bidders shall be discharged/ returned by RBI after award of work to successful bidder.

2.8.5 The Bid Security of the Successful Bidder shall be returned upon the Bidder on virtual completion of the work.

2.9 The Bid Security shall be forfeited:

- (i) Made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted, suppressed any material information, details of any legal proceedings pending in the court which might otherwise would have created any impact on the eligibility criteria; or
- (ii) Bidder left blank the column of the financial bid
- (iii) if a Bidder withdraws his Bid during the period of Bid Validity, or
- (iv) The Bidder has been blacklisted by any government agency and the blacklist is still in force.
- (v) In the case of the Successful Bidder, if he fails to complete the work within the prescribed time limit.

2.10 Procedure for Submission of Bids

On line MSTC portal two part for this tender

2.10.1 Technical Bid consist of following items (PART-I)

- (a) Technical Bid (Section I to Section VI). Please note that prices should not be indicated in the Technical Bid. These documents should be uploaded on MSTC portal and shall be verified by Bank before opening of Part - II. If the firm is not found eligible, Part II of the tender shall not be opened,
- (b) EMD shall be part of Technical bid & shall be uploaded in MSTC portal Part I

2.10.2 Financial Bid (Part-II)

Financial Bid (Section VII) shall be uploaded on MSTC portal

2.10.3 If on opening, it is discovered that the Technical Bid and Financial Bid have combined, the Bid will be liable to be rejected.

2.11 No conditional/optional quote (Part II) shall be accepted.

2.12 Bidders shall not be permitted to alter or modify their bids after receipt of bids.

2.13 Receipt of Bids

The e Tenders will be accepted till the schedule time and date as referred to in **clause 1.2(f). The bids received thereafter shall not be entertained.**

2.14 Opening of Technical Bid

The Technical bids will be opened on the scheduled time and date as referred to in **clause 1.2(g)** at Premises section, CAB, RBI, Pune. The bidders or their authorized representatives may be present, if they so desire.

2.15 Scrutiny of Technical Bid

2.15.1 The Technical bid shall be evaluated as per the procedure indicated in special Condition of contract (section III) based on RFP requirements.

2.15.2 After evaluation of the Technical bids, the short-listed Bidders will be intimated about opening of Financial bid. The decision of the Bank on technical suitability of the offer shall be final and shall not be open for discussion.

2.16 Opening of Financial Bid

The financial bids of the short-listed Bidders will be opened on the date and time intimated to them. The short-listed bidders or their authorized representatives may present, if they so desire.

Scrutiny of Financial Bid

2.17 The Financial bid shall be evaluated as per the procedure indicated in special condition of contract (section III). Accordingly, Lowest bidder (L1) shall be declared.

2.18 Employer's right to accept any Bid and to reject any or all Bids

Notwithstanding anything mentioned above, RBI reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid at any time prior to award of Contract without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders. The Employer shall not assign any reason for rejection of any or all Bids. RBI reserves the right to cancel/annul the selection process, at any stage prior to the award of the Contract on account of the following.

- (a) in case no Bid is received
- (b) occurrence of any event due to which it is not possible to proceed with the selection process.
- (c) an evidence of a possible collaboration/mischief on part of Bidders, impacting the competition and transparency of the selection process,
- (d) any other reason, which in the opinion of the Employer necessitates the cancellation of the selection process
- (e) On occurrence of any such event, RBI shall notify all the Bidders. RBI is not obligated to Provide any reason or clarification to any Bidder on this account. Liability of the RBI under this clause is restricted to returning the Bid Security and no other reimbursements of costs/ expenses of any type shall be made by the employer on this account.
- (f) The Employer further reserves the right to re-tender the process or get the work done by a Government agency or Quasi Government agency if the Employer is of the opinion that the bids received are not economically or otherwise feasible or not acceptable due to reasons in sub clauses (a) to (d) above.

2.19 Virtual Completion

Virtual completion of work is considered after installation, commissioning of STP and after getting statutory approval for necessary operation. A taking over certificate will be issued by the Bank.

SECTION III: Special Condition of the contract

3.1 Evaluation of Bid

Bidders are advised to submit firm proposal to meet the RFP requirement. They have to give a presentation of the system to the Banks Official if required.

3.1.1 Technical Bid

RBI would examine and evaluate responsive technical Bids, as per proposal submitted by the Bidders (format of technical bid selection VI) in line of Bank's requirement mentioned at section V. After evaluation of the technical bids, the short listed Bidders will be intimated about opening of financial bids.

3.1.2 Financial Bid.

(a) Financial bid will be evaluated based on Total cost of ownership (TCO) by using Net Present Value (NPV) method. Calculation of total cost of ownership shall include the following:

- I. The capital Cost(C) quoted and
- II. NPV of the rates quoted for (CAMC) comprehensive all-inclusive Annual Maintenance Contract(A) for a period of Four years after expiry of the defect liability period of one year and
- III. NPV of annual charges(R) for deputing skilled persons at Bank's site, during a period of 5-years from the date of handing over the system to the Bank.

(a).1. For Arriving at the NPV of CAMC amount, a multiplication factor (F) will be computed as per the following parameters.

R = The amount quoted for annual charges for deputing a Skilled person. Firms are requested to ensure minimum wages as per statute are paid to the skilled persons.

- (b) All vendors are requested to quote for items of the price bid independently instead of quoting as lump sum. If, in the price structure quoted by a tenderer in the financial bid, there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (which is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity), the unit price shall prevail and the total price corrected accordingly, unless RBI feels that the tenderer has made a mistake in placing the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall prevail over the unit price and the unit price corrected accordingly.
- (c) If there is an error in a total price, which has been worked out through addition and / or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total corrected; and

3.2 Execution of agreement

On receipt of intimation from the Bank of the acceptance of his RFP, the successful bidder shall be bound to sign the formal contract within fourteen days thereof. The cost of necessary stamp paper for execution of the agreement shall be borne by the bidder/bidder. The format of article of agreement is provided at Section VI. Before completion of defect liability period, successful bidder is required to enter into agreement for comprehensive maintenance contract.

3.3 Defects Liability Period/guarantee

3.3.1 The Defects Liability Period shall be of **one year** from the date of issue of taking over certificate / Virtual certificate.

3.3.2 The Bidder shall, at its own risk and cost, make good, any defects, complete any left-over work as required by the Bank.

3.3.3 The entire system requires 4-years onsite maintenance support excluding defect liability period.

The scope of work as mentioned below are the minimum expected from the firm / agency / contractor apart from break down maintenance and any other work required for operation and maintenance in proper way as per the operation and maintenance manuals of respective equipment and as per good engineering practices will be required to be done under this scope of work. Successful bidder will make Performa for recording the following minimum work schedule/parameters and show to the employer to ensure proper accomplishment of these tasks.

- a. **The scope of work shall cover operation & maintenance of plant in three shift on all seven days of the week and all-in routine, preventive and major/special maintenance works as required from time to time for Operation & Maintenance of STP at CAB campus Pune.**
- b. **Brief details of plants to to operated and maintainted:**
 - (i) ST Plant -13 KLD capacity
- c. All the equipment's/installations shall always be kept in good and trouble-free operating conditions.
- d. All the required record for break-downs/repairs and maintenance etc. shall be maintained in the form of history books and logbooks etc. as per directions.
- e. All the maintenance works shall be carried out in accordance with the direction/instruction of the Engineer in charge.
- f. **If for any reason any equipment is required to be repaired or replaced from the OEM dealer or in any workshop, the contractor shall coordinate with OEM/dealer if repair is done at site. If equipment is to be shifted to OEM factory, same shall be arranged by the agency. For the same extra payment. extra labour will not be paid for the work.**

2. TOOLS & PLANTS

- a. All the general & special tools, tackles required for proper operation and maintenance shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost and issue to the staff deployed by him for this work.

3. WATCH & WARD

- a. Watch and Ward of material, machineries and system etc. till end of the contract shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor and pilferage etc. shall be entirely to his account.

4. PERIOD OF OPERATION

- a. Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) CAB campus Pune be kept under supervision round the clock i.e. 24 hours and 365 days.

5. Schedule of Maintenance: The purpose of testing the systems (STP) is to ensure to avoid break down and continuous delivery of the required system output. An additional purpose is to detect deficiencies of the system not evident by inspection.

7.1 Daily Tests.

- Treated water quality.
- Colour & odor of the treated water.
- Qualified operating personnel shall be in attendance during the daily pump operation.
- **Pump System Procedure.**
- Record the system suction and discharge pressure gauge readings.
- Check the pump packing glands for slight discharge.
- Adjust gland nuts if necessary.
- Check for unusual noise or vibration.
- Check packing boxes, bearings, or pump casing for overheating.

7.2 Monthly tests:

- Testing of treated water quality from the laboratory. To insure that treated water is as per standard parameter of relevant IS Code/guidelines.
- Check working of all the pumps, filters etc.
- Cleaning of all the strainers and chambers of water collection before and after treatment.
- Tighten glands & replace glands Dori if required of all pumps & valves

7.3 Quarterly tests:

- Clean all the sludge from the all the collection chambers, treated water tanks etc.
- Grease all the bearings of pumps & motors.

- Check connections of all the cables, switches and starters on panel.

8. WORK TO BE DONE ON EVERY DAY BASIS:

- The scope of work shall cover manning of STP systems round the clock, operation and all routine, preventive and major /special maintenance works as required from time to time for complete STP System for Operation & Maintenance of Installations.
 - All the equipment/installation shall always be kept in good and trouble-free operating conditions.
 - All the required record for break-downs/repairs and maintenance etc. shall be maintained in the form of history books and logbooks etc. as per directions.
 - All the maintenance works shall be carried out in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications, instructions of the Bank's Officer/ Security officer.
9. **Penalty clause** - If there is a case of dereliction/ absenteeism in the duty/ ratification any delay in attending the minor complaints within twelve hours after lodging the complaint on telephone/e-mail/ official letter in the independent equipment a penalty of Rs.750/- per day and for major breakdown complaint on telephone/e-mail/official letter shall be attended within 24 hours failing which penalty of ₹1500/- per day shall be deducted from the bill payable to the Contractor.

10. TOOLS & PLANTS

All the general & special tools, tackles i/c chain pulley blocks etc., required for proper operation & maintenance and repairs/break down etc., shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost and issue to the staff deployed by him for this work.

11. CONSUMABLES

- The rates shall be all inclusive of establishment as well as required chemical dosing, chlorine etc. All consumables and required quantity chemicals shall be arranged by the contractor for which nothing extra shall be payable.

- b. Log book and complaint books, all stationery like registers, sheets, markers, pens and pencils etc. will be supplied by the contractor and no extra payment for these shall be made.

12. Special Conditions for CAMC:

- 1) The STP at CAB campus Pune. The system is required to be maintained throughout the contract period. The contract covers providing the semi-skilled staff for operation, preventive maintenance, replacement / repairing of defective equipment's etc. Staff deployed may be covered under PF and ESIC (if applicable). Attendance/service/maintenance report shall be maintained duly countersigned by caretaker/ Bank's engineer. Contractor should provide his own biometric attendance system for monitoring attendance (in/out) of their staff. Monthly report generated from the biometric system shall be submitted to Bank along with the bill. Rates quoted by the firm shall be in accordance with Contractor Labour Act 1970/ Minimum Wages Act (Central). Tender having quoted rates below prescribed rates will be rejected. Salary of employees shall be disbursed through NEFT only to their bank account and same details may be sent to RBI for verification
- 2) The quoted rate shall also be inclusive of consumable materials i.e. required chemicals, chlorine, alum, jaggery, waste, calico cloth, grease, petroleum jelly, insulation tape etc.
- 3) The contractor should deploy only semi- skilled persons for operation / maintenance work for the STP system including all associated equipment's / subunits i.e. electrical starter panel including timer, contractors, indicators lamps, fuses, battery charging circuits, engine primer (24V, DC motor) etc.
- 4) The semi- skilled person should have thorough knowledge regarding function of system and operation and maintenance of STP as per technical specifications.
- 5) The deployed staff should be familiar operation of pumps / carrying out preventive maintenance of all the equipment's as per the desired schedule. In each month at least one time all equipment's to be checked for its operation & pumps to be checked for its operational ability / functioning on daily basis.
- 6) The deployed person shall attend the complaint which needs any replacement of spares etc. required for the smooth operation after getting the prior approval from Bank's Officials.
- 7) The deployed person shall attend the complaints on holidays / after office hours also considering the importance of the system, in case of emergency.
- 8) The contract amount shall include of all necessary testing charges /tools/for trail/runs/chemicals etc.
- 9) The charges include for carrying out the periodical preventive maintenance of all the Electrical equipment's and proper register to be maintained and the extract shall be furnished to Premises section CAB Pune along with AMC bills
- 10) Whenever particular equipment goes out of order, the fact shall be brought to the notice of the Bank's Engineer immediately. If any need intimation to Bank's Engineer, material need to be replaced, the same shall arranged within

shortest time. Repair / replacement work shall be taken up immediately and to be completed.

11) **The contractor should provide common phone / Mobile No. to the pump operators in shift duty at Bank and it is accessible to the round the clock for approach them in case of emergency.**

12) The rate quoted should be include for repair/replacement of the equipment in case it develops any defects including operation. In case of any defects, the same shall be repaired within specified period including replacement of spares/components/sub system/chords any other components, part or whole which what so ever, then the defective item/equipment shall be replaced with new equipment without additional cost of the Bank. During such period of repairs or replacement, the contractor shall provide similar standby/spare equivalent temporary for keeping the system in proper working condition.

13). Routine maintenance shall be carried out during the defect liability period and AMC in accordance with Bank requirements, all performance checks undertaking should be recorded

3.3.4 **Operation Cost:** -The entire system requires operation cost, for deputing a skilled engineer cum operator on daily basis (from 9 am to 5 pm) for a period of 5-years, subject to minimum wages specified by Central labour commission from time to time from the date of handing over the site. The operation mainly consists of operating the plant on daily basis and should monitor the load fluctuations of sewerage intake and on the output water parameters and also on the sludge generation and making it fit for use as manure. In addition to operation, will arrange for preventive maintenance, testing of samples, arrangement of required material, liaison with corporation. In his absence or during his leave, weekly off, substitute engineer shall be deployed, failing which proportionate amount will be deducted from AMC bill. Monthly payment as per minimum wage act to the engineer shall be made through Bank account and same shall be submitted to Bank. Helper/s shall be deployed on need basis. The entrusted contractor should provide all precautionary and safety measures for smooth functioning of plant and the skilled person during operation should wear proper uniform with gloves safety shoes and mask. Police verification shall be submitted at periodic interval. And also at site first aid tool kit should be maintained and also it should be seen that the plant is running satisfactory and maintain proper hygiene and clean condition and at any time either during its operation or non-operation period the system should not generate bad odour. Always it should be maintained in clean and dry condition.

A. DEPLOYMENT OF STAFF

- i. The agency shall deploy semi-skilled plant operator and skilled engineer having minimum qualification Diploma in Electrical Engineering/Diploma in Electrical & Electronics Engineering for satisfactory operation and maintenance of STP one shift, further assistance of wiremen for operation of plant will be provided by Bank if required beyond office hours for un-interrupted working of the plants.
- ii. Any extra labour of any nature if required, at any time for attending any repair/break down shall be deployed by the agency at his own cost for which nothing extra shall be payable.
- iii. The deployed labour shall be sufficient, experienced and qualified/trained in operation & maintenance of STP so that all the break downs/repairs are

attended immediately with minimum possible down time. Any unjustified delay in repairing of equipment's shall be treated as breach of contract and suitable penalty shall be imposed and recovered from the monthly bill/security deposited.

a. Break Down period shall not be more than two hours beyond that the penalty clause shall be applicable.

3.3.5 Contractor is advised to take workman's compensation policy every year for the staff operating plant.

3.4 **Liquidated Damages for Delays during execution of work.**

In case the successful bidder is unable to achieve adhere to the project timelines, the bidder will be charged liquidated damages at the rate {refer to clause 1.2}

3.5 **Payment Conditions:**

(i) 1) The 50% payment will be made on getting approval from Maharashtra State Pollution Control Board (MPCB) for consent of establishment and on delivery of goods and material at site. 40% amount on installation and commissioning of STP and balance 10% approval from MPCB on getting consent of operation and on submission of 10% Performance Bank Guarantee for five years.

2) Running account bill will be paid within one month and final bill will be settled within three months after satisfactory completion of work.

Bank may consider paying interest @3% per annum for delayed payment.

3). The rate quoted should be inclusive of doing necessary testing on raw & treated sewerages, inclusive of annual maintenance cost for 5-year inclusive of defect liability period of one year. The maintenance scope mainly consist of , preventive maintenance and breakdown services including all spares ,consumables, etc. during comprehensive Annual maintenance contract period and also inclusive of operation of STP through a skilled person on daily basis for a period of entire Five years.

(ii) Each payment (RA bill & final) is liable to deduct TDS on IT/GST or any other taxes as per the statutory requirements.

The Bidder shall not be liable for forfeiture of its EMD, liquidated damages or termination for default, if the delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is a result of an event of Force Majeure. For purposes of the clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Bidder and not involving the Bidder's fault or Negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, freight embargoes etc. The Reserve Bank of India will decide whether delay or failure on the part of the bidder was the result of an event beyond his control or not. The decision of the Reserve Bank of India in this regard should be final and binding on the supplier and will not be open to question before any court / forum in any proceedings.

3.7 Termination for Default

The Bank may without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract, by Seven Days (07) days written notice of default sent to the Bidder and upon the Bidder's failure and neglect to propose and/or execute, any corrective action to cure the default, terminate this Contract in whole or in part.

3.7.1

- (i) If the Bidder fails to deliver any or all of the items within the time period(s) specified in the Contract; or
- (ii) If the Bidder fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the Contract.

On termination of the Contract the EMD/ Bank Guarantee of the

3.7.2 Bidder will be forfeited.

3.7.3 On termination of the Contract action will be taken to black list the Bidder.

3.7.4 Bank has right to go in court of law if such situation is arises within the jurisdiction indicated in clause 1.3(p).

3.7.5 Termination for Insolvency:

The Bank may at any time terminate the Contract by giving written notice to the Bidder, without compensation to the Bidder, if the Bidder becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to the Bank.

3.8 Patents:

The Bidder shall indemnify the Bank against all claims in respect of patent rights and shall defend all actions arising from such claims and shall himself pay all royalties, licence fees, damages cost and charges of all and every sort that may be legally incurred in respect thereof.

3.9 Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG):

Successful bidder shall submit Performance Bank Guarantee for an amount of **10% of contract value** for the **five years** at the time of submission of final bill to Bank. The format of PBG can be seen at Section VI [annexure 4](#). If performance of the system is not up to the mark during these five years PBG will be forfeited.

In addition to the Performance Bank Guarantee as mentioned above, as further security for the due fulfilment of the contract by the Contractor, 5% of the value of the work done will be deducted by the RBI from each payment to be made to the Contractor towards Retention Money. This total amount (Performance Bank Guarantee + Retention Money) will be termed as Security Deposit. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will be released after award of work and on submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG). RBI will releasethe Performance Bank

Guarantee after completion of work and the remaining Security Deposit after rectification of the defects pointed out during the Defects Liability Period. The amounts retained by the RBI shall not bear any interest.

All compensation or other sums of money payable by the Contractor to the Employer under the terms of this Contract may be deducted from the security deposit if the amount so permits and the Contractor shall, unless such deposit has become otherwise payable, within ten days after such deduction make good in cash the amount so deducted. The security deposit of the successful bidder will be forfeited if he fails to comply with any of the conditions of the Contract.

3.10 Letter of Award

- 3.10.1 The Successful Bidder would be notified in writing by RBI by issuing the Letter of Award (LOA) in favour of the Bidder.
- 3.10.2 Prior to the issue of any Taking-Over Certificate, the successful bidder shall supply to the Engineer the specified numbers and types of copies of the relevant as-built drawings, in accordance with the Employer's Requirements. The Works shall not be considered to be completed for the purposes of taking-over (Taking Over of the Works and Sections) until the Employer has received these documents.
- 3.10.3 The successful bidder shall obtain necessary clearance and any other clearance as per Local Bye-Laws / Conditions from the authorities where ever required
- 3.10.4 **Insurance:** The bidder shall obtain and maintain insurance policies at (a), (b) & (C) in all respect before delivery of material at site and during the execution of the work.

During defect liability period and AMC period policies at (a) & (b) will have to be submitted

- a) Work man compensation for working men at site
- b) Third party liability (Rs 2 lakh per person per accident and 5 Lakhs per accident for damage to property subject to overall ceiling as per extant insurance guidelines)
- c) Contractor's all risk policies for contract value including and fire risk

The vendor(s) need to extend the period of validity of all type of insurance up to extended time in case any extension of time for completion of work is granted by the Bank. Bank will not pay any charges for extending the validity of all type

of insurance for such extended period. In absence of valid policy contractor will be responsible, Bank will take policy for the work at contractor's cost or make proportionate recovery.

3.10.5 The price shall also be firm and shall not be subject to exchange variations, labour conditions, escalation, fluctuations in railway freights or any conditions whatsoever. Bidders must include in their price, excise duty, octroi, **payments to Statutory Authorities**, GST and any other tax and duty prevailing at the time of submission of the RFP and no claim in this regard whatsoever shall be entertained by the Bank.

3.10.6 Testing of System and material

A. The installed capacity of ST Plant shall be got confirmed through consultant/ Third party technical audit in presence of Bank's engineer. Vendor should provide all support & technical details to carry-out the audit. If the capacity is found less, then deduction will be made on pro-rata basis. However, no extra payment will be made if capacity is higher.

B. The contractor shall arrange for manufacturer's test certificate for any material which the bank may require from time to time before execution of work using intended material. The pre-dispatch inspection and testing of material (third party test) shall be carried-out in Govt. /approved laboratory in presence of Bank's engineer as per relevant IS standards as directed by the Bank.

The testing charges only will be reimbursed by the bank on production of vouchers and receipts.

3.10.7 Extension of time: (before expiry of original date of completion)

If the L1 bidders desire any extension of time for completion of work on grounds of their having been unavoidable hindrances in execution or any other ground, they shall apply in writing immediately after the occurrence of the hindrance. Such application shall contain complete details of hindrances, which hindered the contractors in the execution of the work and reference to record of entry in the Hindrance Register. All recording in register shall be recorded jointly by site engineer and contractor's representative. Hindrance pointed out to contractor through email etc shall also be part of hindrance register. The Bank will grant the extension of time, without prejudice to Bank's right to recover liquidated damages or compensation under relevant contract clause. The hindrance due to the Bank will not be the part of calculation of liquidated damages.

3.10.8 Safety and statutory measures: The bidder shall take all safety measure during the execution of the work. The Bank will not accept any liability for any mishap / accident caused while working. The bidder shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Bank against all losses and claims, damages or compensation for breach of any provision of the Payment of Wages Act,1936 Minimum Wages Act 1948, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act,1970, Payment of Bonus Act 1965 amended till date or any other labour law/statute in force in this regard.

3.10.9 Cleanliness: All debris shall be disposed of by the bidder as per the rules and regulation of local authorities concerned beyond the property limits and the site shall be kept free of safety/ fire hazards.

3.10.10 Security Deposit: Security deposit of 10% of contract amount (including GST, interest free) will be deducted from the bill/s and same will be returned as per clause 1.16. All defective spares shall be replaced free of cost during one year of DLP. All Penalties will be recovered from security deposit account.

3.10.11 The Bidder / Agency shall comply with the provisions of “the Sexual Harassment of women at work place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013”. In case of any complaint of sexual harassment against its employee within the premises of the bank, the complaint will be filed before the Internal Complaints Committee constituted by the Bidder / Agency and the Bidder/Agency shall ensure appropriate action under the said Act in respect to the complaint. The bidder shall be responsible for educating its employees about prevention of sexual Harassment at work place and related issues.

(i)Any complaint of sexual harassment from any aggrieved employee of the bidder against any employee of the Bank shall be taken cognizance of by the Regional Complaints Committee constituted by the Bank

3.10.7 Non-Disclosure clause: The Bidder shall not disclose directly or indirectly any information, materials and details of the Bank's infrastructure/systems/equipment etc., which may come to the possession or knowledge of the Bidder during the course of discharging its contractual obligations in connection with this agreement, to any third party and shall at all times hold the same in strictest confidence. The Bidder shall treat the details of the contract as private and confidential, except to the extent necessary to carry out the obligations under it or to comply with applicable laws. The Bidder shall not publish, permit to be published, or disclose any particulars of the works in any trade or technical paper or elsewhere without the previous written consent of the Employer. The Bidder shall indemnify the Employer for any loss suffered by the Employer as a result of disclosure of any confidential information. Failure to observe the above shall be treated as breach of contract on the part of the Bidder and the Employer shall be entitled to claim damages and pursue legal remedies. The Bidder shall take all appropriate actions with respect to its employees to ensure that the obligations of non-disclosure of confidential information under this agreement are fully satisfied. The Bidder's obligations with respect to non- disclosure and confidentiality will survive the expiry or termination of this agreement for whatever reason.

SAFETY CODE

1. Suitable scaffolds should be provided for workmen for all works that cannot safely be done from the ground, or from solid construction except such short period work as can be done safely from ladders. When a ladder is used, an extra mazdoor shall be engaged for holding the ladder and if the ladder is used for carrying materials as well suitable footholds and handhold shall be provided on the ladder and the ladder shall be given an inclination not steeper than $\frac{1}{4}$ to 1 ($\frac{1}{4}$ horizontal and 1 vertical.)
2. Scaffolding of staging more than 3.6 m (12ft.) above the ground or floor, swung or suspended from an overhead support or erected with stationary support shall have a guard rail properly attached or bolted, braced and otherwise secured at least 90 cm. (3ft.) high above the floor or platform of such scaffolding or staging and extending along the entire length of the outside and ends thereof with only such opening as may be necessary for the delivery of materials. Such scaffolding or staging shall be so fastened as to prevent it from swaying from the building or structure.
3. Working platforms, gangways and stairways should be so constructed that they should not sag unduly or unequally, and if the height of the platform or the gangway or the stairway is more than 3.6 m (12ft.) above ground level or floor level, they should be closely boarded, should have adequate width and should be suitably fastened as described in (2) above.
4. Every opening in the floor of a building or in a working platform shall be provided with suitable means to prevent the fall of person or materials by providing suitable fencing or railing whose minimum height shall be 90 cm. (3ft.)
5. Safe means of access shall be provided to all working platforms and other working places. Every ladder shall be securely fixed. No portable single ladder shall be over 9m. (30ft.) in length while the width between side rails in rung ladder shall in no case be less than 29 cm. (11½") for ladder up to and including 3 m. (10 ft.) in length. For longer ladders, this width should be increased at least $\frac{1}{4}$ " for each additional 30 cm. (1 foot) of length. Uniform step spacing of not more than 30 cm shall be kept. Adequate precautions shall be taken to prevent danger from electrical equipment. No materials on any of the sites or work shall be so stacked or placed as to cause danger or inconvenience to any person or the public. The contractor shall provide all necessary fencing and lights to protect the public from accident and shall be bound to bear the expenses of defence of every suit, action or other proceedings at law that may be brought by any person for injury sustained owing to neglect of the above precautions and to pay any damages and cost which may be awarded in any such suit; action or proceedings to any such person or which may, with the consent of the contractor, be paid to compensate any claim by any such person.
6. (a) Excavation and Trenching - All trenches 1.2 m. (4ft.) or more in depth, shall at all times be supplied with at least one ladder for each 30 m. (100 ft.) in length or

fraction thereof, Ladder shall extend from bottom of the trench to at least 90 cm. (3ft.) above the surface of the ground. The side of the trenches which are 1.5 m. (5ft.) or more in depth shall be stepped back to give suitable slope or securely held by timber bracing, so as to avoid the danger of sides collapsing. The excavated materials shall not be placed within 1.5 m. (5ft.) of the edges of the trench or half of the depth of the trench whichever is more. Cutting shall be done from top to bottom. Under no circumstances, undermining or undercutting shall be done.

(b) Safety Measures for digging bore holes:-

- (i). If the bore well is successful, it should be safely capped to avoid caving and collapse of the bore well. The failed and the abandoned ones should be completely refilled to avoid caving and collapse;
- (ii). During drilling, sign boards should be erected near the site with the address of the drilling contractor and the Engineer in-charge of the work;
- (iii). Suitable fencing should be erected around the well during the drilling and after the installation of the rig on the point of drilling, flags shall be put 50m around the point of drilling to avoid entry of people;
- (iv). After drilling the borewell, a cement platform (0.50m x 0.50m x 1.20m) 0.60m above ground level and 0.60m below ground level should be constructed around the well casing;
- (v). After the completion of the borewell, the contractor should cap the bore well properly by welding steel plate, cover the bore well with the drilled wet soil and fix thorny shrubs over the soil. This should be done even while repairing the pump;
- (vi). After the borewell is drilled the entire site should be brought to the ground level.

7. Demolition - Before any demolition work is commenced and also during the progress of the work,

- (i) All roads and open areas adjacent to the work site shall either be closed or suitably protected.
- (ii) No electric cable or apparatus which is liable to be a source of danger or a cable or apparatus used by the operator shall remain electrically charged.
- (iii) All practical steps shall be taken to prevent danger to persons employed from risk of fire or explosion or flooding. No floor, roof or other part of the building shall be so overloaded with debris or materials as to render it unsafe.

8. All necessary personal safety equipment as considered adequate by the Engineer-in-Charge should be kept available for the use of the person employed on the site and maintained in a condition suitable for immediate use, and the contractor should take adequate steps to ensure proper use of equipment by those concerned. The following safety equipment shall invariably be provided:

- (i) Workers employed on mixing asphaltic materials, cement and lime

mortars shall be provided with protective footwear and protective goggles.

- (ii) Those engaged in white washing and mixing or stacking of cement bags or any material which is injurious to the eyes, shall be provided with protective goggles.
- (iii) Those engaged in welding works shall be provided with welder's protective eye shields.
- (iv) Stone breaker shall be provided with protective goggles and protective clothing and seated at sufficiently safe intervals.
- (v) When workers are employed in sewers and manholes, which are in active use, the contractors shall ensure that the manhole covers are opened and ventilated at least for an hour before the workers are allowed to get into the manholes, and the manholes so opened shall be cordoned off with suitable railing and provided with warning signals or boards to prevent accident to the public. In addition, the contractor shall ensure that the following safety measure are adhered to: -
 - (a) Entry for workers into the line shall not be allowed except under supervision of the JE or any other higher officer.
 - (b) At least 5 to 6 manholes upstream and downstream should be kept open for at least 2 to 3 hours before any man is allowed to enter into the manhole for working inside.
 - (c) Before entry, presence of Toxic gases should be tested by inserting wet lead acetate paper which changes colour in the presence of such gases and gives indication of their presence.
 - (d) Presence of Oxygen should be verified by lowering a detector lamp into the manhole. In case, no Oxygen is found inside the sewer line, workers should be sent only with Oxygen kit.
 - (e) Safety belt with rope should be provided to the workers. While working inside the manholes, such rope should be handled by two men standing outside to enable him to be pulled out during emergency.
 - (f) The area should be barricaded or cordoned off by suitable means to avoid mishaps of any kind. Proper warning signs should be displayed for the safety of the public whenever cleaning works are undertaken during night or day.
 - (g) No smoking or open flames shall be allowed near the blocked manhole being cleaned.
 - (h) The malba obtained on account of cleaning of blocked manholes and sewer lines should be immediately removed to avoid accidents on account of slippery nature of the malba.
 - (i) Workers should not be allowed to work inside the manhole continuously. He should be given rest intermittently. The Engineer-in-Charge may decide the time up to which a worker may be allowed to work continuously inside the manhole.

- (j) Gas masks with Oxygen Cylinder should be kept at site for use in emergency.
 - (k) Air-blowers should be used for flow of fresh air through the manholes. Whenever called for, portable air blowers are recommended for ventilating the manholes. The Motors for these shall be vapour proof and of totally enclosed type. Non sparking gas engines also could be used but they should be placed at least 2 metres away from the opening and on the leeward side protected from wind so that they will not be a source of friction on any inflammable gas that might be present.
 - (l) The workers engaged for cleaning the manholes/sewers should be properly trained before allowing to work in the manhole.
 - (m) The workers shall be provided with Gumboots or non-sparking shoes bump helmets and gloves non sparking tools safety lights and gas masks and portable air blowers (when necessary). They must be supplied with barrier cream for anointing the limbs before working inside the sewer lines.
 - (n) Workmen descending a manhole shall try each ladder stop or rung carefully before putting his full weight on it to guard against insecure fastening due to corrosion of the rung fixed to manhole well.
 - (o) If a man has received a physical injury, he should be brought out of the sewer immediately and adequate medical aid should be provided to him.
 - (p) The extent to which these precautions are to be taken depend on individual situation but the decision of the Engineer-in-Charge regarding the steps to be taken in this regard in an individual case will be final.
- (vi) The Contractor shall not employ men and women below the age of 18 years on the work of painting with products containing lead in any form. Wherever men above the age of 18 are employed on the work of lead painting, the following precaution should be taken: -
- (a) No paint containing lead or lead products or product containing these pigment shall be used except in the form of paste or ready-made paint.
 - (b) Suitable face masks should be supplied for use by the workers when paint is applied in the form of spray or a surface having paint is dry rubbed and scrapped.
 - (c) Overalls shall be supplied by the contractors to the workmen and shall be worn by working painters during the whole of working period.
 - (d) Adequate facilities shall be provided to enable the working painters to wash during and on the cessation of work.
 - (e) Suitable arrangements shall be made to prevent clothing put off during working hours being spoiled by painting materials.

- (f) Cases of lead poisoning and suspected lead poisoning shall be notified and shall be subsequently verified by medical man appointed by competent authority.
 - (g) Instructions with regard to special hygienic precautions to be taken in the painting trade shall be distributed to working painters.
 - (h) Employer may require medical examination of workers, when necessary.
- 9. When the work is done near any place where there is risk of drowning, all necessary equipment's should be provided and kept ready for use and all necessary steps taken for prompt rescue of any person in danger and adequate provision, should be made for prompt first aid treatment of all injuries likely to be obtained during the course of the work.
- 10. Use of hoisting machines and tackle including their attachments, anchorage and supports shall conform to the following standards or conditions: -
 - (i) (a) These shall be of good mechanical construction, sound materials and adequate strength and free from patent defects and shall be kept repaired and in good working order.
 - (b) Every rope used in hoisting or lowering materials or as a means of suspension shall be of durable quality and adequate strength, and free from patent defects.
 - (ii) Every crane driver or hoisting appliance operator, shall be properly qualified and no person under the age of 21 years should be in charge of any hoisting machine including any scaffolding winch or give signals to operator.
 - (iii) In case of every hoisting machine and of every chain ring hook, shackle swivel and pulley block used in hoisting or as means of suspension, the safe working load shall be ascertained by adequate means. Every hoisting machine and all gear referred to above shall be plainly marked with the safe working load. In case of a hoisting machine having a variable safe working load, each safe working load and the condition under which it is applicable shall be clearly indicated. No part of any machine or any gear referred to above in this paragraph shall be loaded beyond the safe working load except for the purpose of testing.
 - (iv) The contractor shall notify the safe working load of the machine to the Engineer-in-Charge whenever he brings any machinery to site of work.
- 11. Motors, gearing, transmission, electric wiring and other dangerous parts of hoisting appliances should be provided with efficient safeguards. Hoisting appliances should be provided with such means as will reduce to the minimum the risk of accidental descent of the load. Adequate precautions should be taken to reduce to the minimum the risk of any part of a suspended load becoming accidentally displaced. When workers are employed on electrical installations which are already energized, insulating mats, wearing apparel, such as gloves, sleeves and boots as may be necessary should be provided. The worker should not wear any rings, watches and carry keys or other materials which are good conductors of electricity.

12. All scaffolds, ladders and other safety devices mentioned or described herein shall be maintained in safe condition and no scaffold, ladder or equipment shall be altered or removed while it is in use. Adequate washing facilities should be provided at or near places of work.
13. These safety provisions should be brought to the notice of all concerned by display on a notice board at a prominent place at work spot. The person responsible for compliance of the safety code shall be named therein by the contractor. First-aid appliances, including adequate supply of sterilized dressings and cotton wool, shall be maintained in a readily accessible place.
14. To ensure effective enforcement of the rules and regulations relating to safety precautions the arrangements made by the contractor shall be open to inspection by the Labour Officer or Engineer-in-Charge of the Employer or their representatives.

Notwithstanding the above clauses from (1) to (14), there is nothing in these to exempt the contractor from the operations of any other Act or Rule in force in the country.
